Prayer for leaders and practitioners who attended GCMAR Leadership and Coaches Training (2017-2020)

(Day 22) May 15, 2020

- 1. Pray for the over 1,500 leaders and practitioners from different Divisions who went through the GCAMR training. Pray that God may continue to inspire them as they lead out this ministry in their respective territories. Pray for those who acquired this knowledge for the first time that they may be motivated to learn more as they grow in this ministry.
- 2. Pray for the ongoing trainings at Union levels. Pray that God may nurture those who have been trained earlier to be effective trainers in their territories and that the Holy Spirt may lead them to establish ministries among Muslim communities.
- 3. Pray that God may continue to raise new talents in the AMR ministry and make His work grow exponentially.

(Day 23) May 16, 2020

(Day 24) May 17, 2020

- 1. Pray for a loving attitude amongst Adventists, that we may be able to touch the hearts of millions of Muslims around the globe by our kind acts. Pray that by our lives and actions we will draw many.
- 2. Pray for the Total Member Involvement program that through it we can engage every member in doing their part to share God's loving-kindness that by God's grace both members and our Muslim cousins will deepen their experience of God and His message.
- 3. Pray that Muslims who are searching for another way to God yet weary of modern day Christianity may find the Adventist church a safe space in which to pursue the one true God, His kingdom and His righteousness.

(Day 25) May 18, 2020

- 2. Pray for all Muslims who are suffering from different types of illness. Pray for those who may need deliverance from evil powers.
- 3. Pray that Adventist will pray for God's healing power to be upon Muslim lands. Pray for a wave of healing through miracles among Muslim communities across the globe

Prayer for Jesus to reveal Himself to Muslims around the world

(Day 26) May 19, 2020

- 1. Pray that Christ Jesus may reveal Himself to Muslims in unique ways. May Muslims around the world see Jesus in ways that will make them realise that He is more than a prophet. Pray that He may demonstrate His Lordship among them.
- 2. Pray also that millions of Muslims who are reading their *Qur'an* will be able to see Jesus in their holy book as more than a prophet.
- 3. Pray that Adventist members around the world will be able to explain about Jesus in their familiar associations, in the words and language of Islam that those who hear may understand and be reached by this truth. May many Adventists become an avenue by which Muslims can truly understand about the divinity of Jesus in order that Christ's prayer in John 17:3 may be fulfilled, "Now this is eternal life: that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent."

JOHN 4:25-29 NKJV (selected)

²⁵The woman said to Him, "I know that Messiah is coming" (who is called Christ). "When He comes, He will tell us all things..." ²⁶Jesus said to her, "I who speak to you am He..." ²⁸The woman then left her waterpot, went her way into the city, and said to the men, ²⁹"Come, see a Man who told me all things that I ever did. Could this be the Christ?"







Prayer for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit

(Day 27) May 20, 2020

- 1. Let's claim the promise of the Holy Spirit on behalf of Muslims who are praying to Allah for his revelation in their lives. Let's pray that during the night of the 27th day of the month of Ramadan (*Lyilat al-Qadr*-night of power), that the Holy Spirt will reveal Himself in the lives of Muslims.
- 2. Pray that God's mercy and forgiveness through Jesus Christ will be experienced among Muslims.
- 3. Pray for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit to those working among Muslim communities. That God may reveal Himself through their different ministries.

JOEL 2:28 NKJV

"And it shall come to pass afterward, That I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your old men shall dream dreams, Your young men shall see visions.







Pray for God to send dreams and visions

(Day 28) May 21, 2020

- 1. Pray that God may send dreams and visions to Muslim believers in this last week of the Ramadan. Pray that Jesus may appear to Muslim leaders and those who are seeking for hope and peace of mind in these last days of crisis.
- 2. Pray for all Muslims who have reached dreams and visions and accepted Jesus Christ as their Lord and saviour that they may be a source of light to their family members.
- 3. Pray that God may establish an Adventist Movement among Muslim communities through dreams and visions.

GENESIS 28:12-13 NKJV

¹²Then he dreamed, and behold, a ladder was set up on the earth, and its top reached to heaven; and there the angels of God were ascending and descending on it. ¹³And behold, the Lord stood above it and said: "I am the Lord God of Abraham your father and the God of Isaac; the land on which you lie I will give to you and your descendants.







Pray for Pakistan

(Day 28) May 21, 2020

- 1. Pray for Adventists in Pakistan. Pray that their influence will be used of God to extend His ministry in Pakistan, among the more than 180 million people.
- 2. Pray for the influence of Pakistani Muslim leaders in government and other sectors in the West to open the doors for ministry.
- 3. Pray that God will touch the hearts of some top leaders in the government to facilitate God's ministry.

Pray for Nigeria

(Day 29) May 22, 2020

- 1. Pray for the 102 Muslim people group in Nigeria. Pray that God will send forth laborers into this part of His rich harvest field, missionaries who will minister to them in righteousness in culturally appropriate ways.
- 2. Pray that God will turn the hearts of radical and militant Muslims who are operating there. Pray that God will send His Holy Spirit to soften their positions and that He may flood their hearts with His love towards humanity.
- 3. Pray for those who are impacted by the Muslim radicalism and militancy that has been going on in parts of Nigeria. Pray that they may know God's comfort and God's power, and that the atrocities and suffering that they have undergone may serve to turn their hearts to search for the true Way (John 14:6).

¹¹For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope. ¹²Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. ¹³And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart.
